Elonva®

- It is a recombinant gonadotropin, corifollitropin alfa. This medication is unique in that it acts on the FSH receptor, but its molecule is modified by combining FSH with hCG, allowing it to have a prolonged duration of action of up to 7 days. As a result, daily injections are not required.
- The medication is supplied as a pre-filled syringe in two strengths: 100 and 150 mcg.
- Hormonal injections generally produce better results than oral medications because the hormone is injected directly to stimulate the egg-production process.
- Possible side effects include mood swings, headache, nausea, and vomiting.
