

## Follitrope®

- It is a recombinant FSH (follitropin beta) synthesized using a Chinese hamster ovary (CHO) cell line.
- It is an injectable ovulation-stimulating medication that enhances the action of the FSH hormone.
- Hormonal injections generally produce better results than oral medications because the hormone is injected directly to stimulate the egg-production process. Eggs obtained from hormonal injections are usually of better quality than those from oral medication and can help women produce up to 20 or more eggs in a single cycle (whereas oral ovulation-induction drugs typically result in 1–3 eggs).
- It is supplied as a prefilled syringe in strengths of 75, 150, 225, and 300 IU.
- Possible side effects include mood swings, headache, nausea, and vomiting.
