Rekovel®

- It is a recombinant FSH (follitropin delta) synthesized from a human fetal retinal cell line, allowing the hormone structure to be modified to more closely resemble that of humans.
- It is an injectable ovulation-stimulating medication that enhances the action of the FSH hormone.
- Hormonal injections generally produce better results than oral medications because the hormone is injected directly to stimulate the egg-production process. Eggs obtained from hormonal injections are usually of better quality than those from oral medication and can help women produce up to 20 or more eggs in a single cycle (whereas oral ovulation-induction drugs typically result in 1–3 eggs).
- It is supplied as a pre-filled pen in three strengths: 12, 36, and 72 mcg. The dose can be adjusted by rotating the dial. If the dose is over- or under-adjusted, it can be rotated back and forth to set the desired dose. However, do not press the injection button at the needle end while adjusting the dose.
- Possible side effects include mood swings, headache, nausea, and vomiting.
